About Us

The mission of the Enchanted Closet, Inc. is to physically, mentally, and emotionally outfit Metro Atlanta high school girls from low-income families through programs that prepare them for social and professional milestones.

The Enchanted Closet, Inc. began as a service project to provide prom dresses to girls in metro Atlanta that may not have otherwise had the opportunity to experience the joy of attending one of the most memorable events in a teenager's life. With the tremendous support and overwhelming response of citizens and businesses in Atlanta, the Enchanted Closet incorporated in 2003, and has grown into a full blown non-profit service organization that takes a holistic approach to empowering girls. **The Enchanted Closet's purpose is to cultivate the self awareness, self esteem, and self sufficiency of girls.**

Excellence

The Enchanted Closet, Inc. was presented the 2010 Lighthouse Award by Lambda Epsilon Omega Chapter, AKA Sorority, Inc. and the 2008 Georgia State University President's Outstanding Community Partner Award for Community Service and Social Action, and is a recipient of the Independent Charities Seal of Excellence. The Seal of Excellence is awarded to the members of Independent Charities of America and Local Independent Charities of America that have, upon rigorous independent review, been able to certify, document, and demonstrate on an annual basis that they meet the highest standards of public accountability, program effectiveness, and cost effectiveness.



Service

Realizing the connection between clothing and self esteem, we strive to boost the confidence and self esteem of girls by making sure they look and feel good not just on prom night, but for the rest of their lives. Over **4000** girls have received dresses through the **Prom Dress Giveaway Program**.

The **GIRL\$ Service Learning Program** combines monthly classroom instruction with community service, and provides tools for enhanced self awareness, self esteem, and self sufficiency through mentoring and life skills workshops that stress economic and social entrepreneurship. More than **500** girls have benefited from life skills workshops provided by the organization since 2004.

Other programs include **GIRL\$ READ! Book Club**, sponsored by Kimani Tru, a Harlequin imprint developed to increase the readership of urban teens, and **GIRL\$ MOVE! Health and Wellness Program**, inspired by the National Let's Move! Initiative and developed to reduce obesity and promote more healthy eating.
